Comments	<input type="text" value="Dear Matthew Chadwick, Planning Ref: 19/02796/F Recreation Ground, MUGA and Pavilion I wish to comment on the above numbered planning application. When we decided to make our home in Henge Close backing onto the playing field (the subject of this application) we were assured that it was to be developed for football. We appreciated there might be some kind of pavilion, but did not envisage such a vast building as now planned with a MUGA and floodlighting, or that it would be licensed for commercial use as weddings, parties, and conferences including a public bar and space for a large volume of cars, mini buses and coaches. We assumed it was to be for the local village use only. My main objection is the planned position for car and motorbike parking for over 100 vehicles at the end of residents' back gardens. This will impact the families concerned to a great extent. There will be noise and pollution throughout the day and night. The police submission highlights the fact that the Design and Access Statement does not adequately address crime and disorder or fear of crime. The car park could and should be re-positioned well away from residents.
