For many years the only sport area has been the Lucy Placket with a prefab building used for some village clubs and a very old dilapidated prefab building used for the football club as changing rooms

and club house. Access to the Lucy Placket is through Round Close Road which is a narrow village road with parking for a few houses on the road only. There is also limited parking on the Lucy Placket
