Hello,

I am not sure if you are still taking comments on the planning application 19/02796/F, the sports facility on Milton Road, Adderbury, but just incase you are I thought it was worth passing my comments on.

I think the proposed sports facility is a good idea, with the provision for various sports groups, badminton, group classes etc so hopefully it is an asset to the local community.

I live in the housing estate opposite and have a few concerns about it.

- I currently walk my dog across this field to get to the fields behind and walk at the bottom of the railway line to Milton and Bloxham. Will walkers still be allowed to walk around the perimeter of the site?

- Why doesn't the exterior have to be in keeping with the local area? Surely the exterior should be like the frontages of the new housing developments with cotswold stone looking buildings? Radstone School on the new estate in Brackley is more what I expected this to look like.

- Does the entrance need to be so close to the neighbouring streets? Surely it would make it easier for traffic if the entrance was at the other end of the site?

- I am concerned there isn't enough car parking for peak times; particularly if there's cross over between one group of users and the next. This can be an issue at Deddington's Windmill centre. Although mentioned, I couldn't see where overflow parking is, and would there be space for more cars if this wasn't adequate?
