The applicant has submitted an overarching written scheme of investigation from EDP for the staged programme of archaeological evaluation and mitigation required by condition 43 of permission 14/01932/OUT.

This WSI is acceptable and meets the requirements of condition 43. As such we are satisfied that this condition (43) can be discharged.

A contractor specific WSI from Oxford Archaeology has also been submitted but this WSI merely sets out how they will undertake the work set out in the overarching WSI from EDP and does not affect this application.

The applicant has also applied to discharge condition 44. This condition requires that the archaeological mitigation work set out in the agreed overarching WSI by EDP is undertaken as specified. This work has commenced but has not yet been completed or reported as set out in this agreed WSI.

We would therefore not recommend the discharge of condition 44 at this stage.

Condition 45 requires that a method statement setting out how the Neolithic enclosure will be protected during the development. This method statement has been agreed and submitted with this discharge application.

As such we are satisfied that Condition 45 can be discharged.
