Apologies for the delay.

Whilst removals are mentioned within the tree survey report, there are currently no plans such as an Arboricultural Impact Assessment detailing which trees are to be removed in order to implement the proposal. Equally, there does not appear to be any plans detailing trees to be retained, and how their RPAs sit within the proposal.

In line with the above, once the layout of the proposal has been agreed a Method statement may be required in order to detail how retained trees will be protected.

The trees on site shouldn't offer a constraint to the proposal. However, the above items will need confirming.
