My husband, Dave, spoke to someone (maybe lan) in the Dept and talked him through the situation.

There is a hyrbid poplar in our garden. We were told from the previous owner it is forty-something years old. I'm told it is getting old for a hybrid poplar and it is close to our house. The recent winds - where another tree came down in our garden - have also made me conscious of the danger as it gets older, and i have young children.

It dpesn't have a TPO. It \*might\* not even be in the conservation area (lan took a look on the plans when we spoke and it looks ambiguous). We own a field connected to the house and the boundary of the conservation area looks to run right up to the tree, so I don't know whether that means it is in or out (but didn't want to get it wrong, so thought I'd put an applicaiton in.

We want to fell it.

We're happy to plant more trees (hybrid poplars, if that is important). We have planted 13 already, in the two months weve lived here and are planning on lots more. We like trees, just not ones that might drop a branch on hour house, a neighbour of a person.
