My reasons are much the same as of all those who have expressed their objection, on the grounds of continued ribbon development along this road, environmental damage, etc, etc.

However, having visited the site and made a careful study of the plans, I would to draw your attention to the following:

- A. The plans show, what appears to be 70+ static [immobile] mobile, portacabin type, camp dwellings, closely set out and with no indication of the vehicles that would have towed them in, or would tow them away, after the occupants "holiday" was over. The way the whole plan is set out it does not have the appearance of a typical Caravan Club site.
- B. For the above, considerable services, infrastructure, would be needed, I.e. Water, Electricity, Sewage disposal.
- C. The entrance to the track, which leads on to a remote dwelling, is totally unsuitable and major roadworks would be required to cope with the quantity of envisaged movements and the size of caravans being towed by large 4 x 4's or similar. As you will already know, the Milton/Adderbury Road now has vastly more traffic [some speeding] as a result of the estate developments that have taken place in recent years and this would only add to the already perilous situation.
