Dear Mr Neville,

I have been given your name as the appropriate person to write to in order to object to the above planning application. If this is incorrect I would be grateful if you could pass my objection on to whoever is the appropriate planning officer.

I would like to object to the application on the following grounds:

1. The proposed use is inappropriate to the rural nature of the site. It will be a standalone development surrounded by open land and as such not in keeping with the surrounding area. It will lead to the increased urbanisation of the area between Adderbury and Milton.
2. The proposed development of this site a little way along the Milton Road will continue a tendency towards ribbon development along the road which has already taken place over the last two years with the development of new housing estates at both the Adderbury and Bloxham ends of the Milton Road. Ribbon development should be discouraged by Cherwell Council.
3. The existence of a caravan park will further increase traffic on the Milton Road. Traffic has increased in recent years and already the Milton Road is used as a speed track by some motorists. It is only a matter of time before there is a serious accident on the Milton Road and increasing the number of vehicles turning onto the road will increase the risk of accidents.

For the above reasons I hope that Cherwell District Council will reject this planning application.
