<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I have lived in Steeple Aston for 16 years and in all those years I do not drive towards Steeple Aston Road Middle Aston in the mornings and afternoons on School days because I put safety first for the children and parents going to and from school in that area. Safety is the number one objection for me and I know it must be for you when planning is submitted and assessed. I have walked that area when going to the church allotments at school times and it is very busy with lots of cars and pedestrians just coping to pass each other on the narrow roads and narrow pavements thinking to myself it is a good job no other traffic uses this road much. Access to Hatch End from either way (Steeple Aston &amp; Middle Aston) for a complex as described is a safety hazard especially as there is no footpath from Middle Aston to the schools and play/sports area on that road. The roads in Steeple Aston can not be changed example by the church to make it safe for large volumes of traffic, and other places in the village are stone walled and narrow with blind corners. All very risky on a quiet normal day going to and from work for parishioners. Think Safe!"/>
