<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="We consider that this proposal is very unfortunate. At the moment Steeple Aston, a village, ends quietly just after the primary school and although the chicken sheds have been there for many years they are not urban or intrusive and thus there is a pleasant country walk from Steeple Aston to Middle Aston. The road is poor and wholly unsuitable for much traffic. If this proposal goes through, it will totally alter the character of both villages. In particular, it will cause danger to the children and families of Steeple Aston school and it will also mean that there will be considerably more traffic in Steeple Aston itself. As it is, the roads here are less safe than they were because cars frequently speed at more than 30 m.p.h. As the committee knows not only is there the school but a large retired population. Furthermore, the parking will present problems as will the construction traffic along an old fashioned country road. The answer is NO to this proposal."/>
