Further to my email correspondence dated 27<sup>th</sup> May 2020 regarding the application referenced 20/01316/TEL56 relating to the 'Land West Of Buildings 138 & 139 Bicester Heritage Adjacent To Skimmingdish Lane Launton'.

I write to formally request that you provide an extension of time to enable us to fully assess the implications of this proposal on aviation at the aerodrome. This is on the basis that the applicant has only notified the Bicester Gliding Club and not Bicester Motion the airfield landowner and airfield operator from July 1<sup>st</sup> 2020.

We have not received any notification of the application and it was only by our request that information has been provided on the 27<sup>th</sup> May

We request that you allow us a period of 15 working days to assess the implications of this application on aviation activity, we will endeavour to respond sooner if possible.

We must also notify you that the assessment states that there are no Schools or Colleges within close proximity of the site however there are two colleges located on our site in close proximity to this proposal and there is also a live planning application (ref 20/00842/F) to allow the change of use of Building 140 to D1 (Education) at the New Technical Site, Bicester Heritage directly adjacent to the proposed mast location and trust this will be considered in your assessment.
