An elevated development in the planned location will have a negative effect on the rural character of Fringford and particularly the environmental impact on Rectory Lane. The proposed driveway is dangerously sited on a blind bend on to the already busy single-tracked Rectory Lane. On-road parking is an existing issue on our stretch of Rectory Lane regularly restricting access to our property. During any construction and, more importantly, in the longer term, the proposed 4-bed property, with limited parking spaces, would only exacerbate the current situation further obstructing crucial access to many Rectory Lane properties.
