

## ANALYSIS OF THE LOCALITY

### 2.1 DISTRIBUTION OF TYPOLOGIES

The map below highlights all of the built form in the vicinity of the site, with blue for the houses (typically ironstone cottages), and red for agricultural buildings, which form the majority of the dispersed isolated development, and are perhaps therefore the more relevant precedent for our development, which will add to this pattern.



Zooming in on all of these isolated rural buildings in the vicinity of the site, they are rarely on their own and are typically in small groupings, arranged at right angles to each other.



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**2.3 ISOLATED RURAL BUILDINGS**



These agricultural buildings are sometimes clad in metal, and some are built of ironstone, (as left), but the majority are clad in weathered vertical timber boarding, as shown in the images below / right.
