Comments	<input type="text" value="Planning Application 20/02060/F - The Stables OBJECTION Dear Sir/Madam, I write with regard to the above planning application number to allow several caravans to be sited on the lane between Great Bourton and Cropredy and to register my objection to this plan. Great Bourton is a lovely rural community with many young families, many who walk between the two villages to the school and back and will need to pass the gypsy caravans at least twice a day if this goes ahead - can you guarantee their safety? There is a public right of way through the proposed application but who will be able to use it? There is a very real risk to public safety and our property if this goes ahead. The caravans will be visible from the top of the hill (where my property is situated) and I believe will have a detrimental effect to the property prices within both Great Bourton and Cropredy, will the council be willing to underwrite the loss? The site itself is very often flooded and the caravans would not be in keeping with the general beauty of our surroundings.
