I write to register my strong objections to the above planning application on the following grounds: 1. As a resident of Station Road, Cropredy some 600 yards from the proposed change of use at this site I believe if allowed this application would seriously and adversely impact on my home and its saleable value. 2. Flooding - this area of the road has always flooded and the site referred to in this application does have flooding problems. Hard-core standing on the site would make flooding more likely, this would again cause thousands of pounds worth damage to the School and School House, this has happened at least twice in the past years 3. There is a public footpath across the site. Concern that it will not be usable if families with their homes and animals are obstructing the right of way. Walkers use this right of way and it would deter walkers if walking through peoples Homes & Animal enclosures. 4. Access - I consider the access to the site is a danger to all road users. The road to and from Gt Bourton sees a large volume (and high speed) of traffic during many hours of the day. Work commuters from the village and traffic from the A361 use the road as a rat run to access Banbury. A high volume of traffic / parked cars is also experienced during school hours. 6. The rural aspect (Ridge & Furrow) of the land between Gt.
