I find the seemingly creeping nature of the whole process disturbing due to the longevity of it all. Why is there no planning notice posted at the site for example. Also, when will we see the end of this. As has been pointed out, the field on the opposite side had mains water installed some two or three years ago. The field also had considerable ground work done last year, resulting in two manholes within the field, and outside the gate a sewage manhole. This can only mean plans for further development, so I repeat, when will it end. As for other developments, Cropredy has had fourteen new properties built in recent years, plus the currently "on hold" plans for the land adjacent to the railway line, and then we have the small matter of 340 canal boat moorings in full view of the northern Cropredy residents. The latter was hotly disputed by villagers, myself included, but somehow obtained approval. Surely the area has fulfilled its ' quota in all areas, including an existing site for travellers just a mile up the road, and I strongly object to any further developments.
