| Comments | <input type="text" value="I would like to endorse fully the comments and opinions of both the Parish Council and the CPRE and I would take this opportunity to expand briefly on one of the safety aspects of their objections. The existing road and footpath corridor provided via main street has, for generations, enabled the safe transit of people and goods between Great Bourton and Cropredy. This facility currently enjoys a high level of safety for both pedestrians and traffic and this is largely due to the clear passage, with no significant junctions, between the two villages. Any development which increases unpredictable traffic turnings and movements on this relatively steep gradient thoroughfare would, inevitably, increase the danger to all users of this corridor."/> |
