I strongly object to this application on a number of grounds. Additional traffic at this section of road will cause further disruption and congestion on an already busy road due to the

nearby primary school - particularly during school drop off and pick up times when the road is limited to single file - further increasing risk to safety of children and other road users. The introduction of caravans is not in keeping with the surrounding agricultural which has 'high landscape value' and this detrimental visual change will devalue surrounding property. Light pollution and noise are additional concerns.
