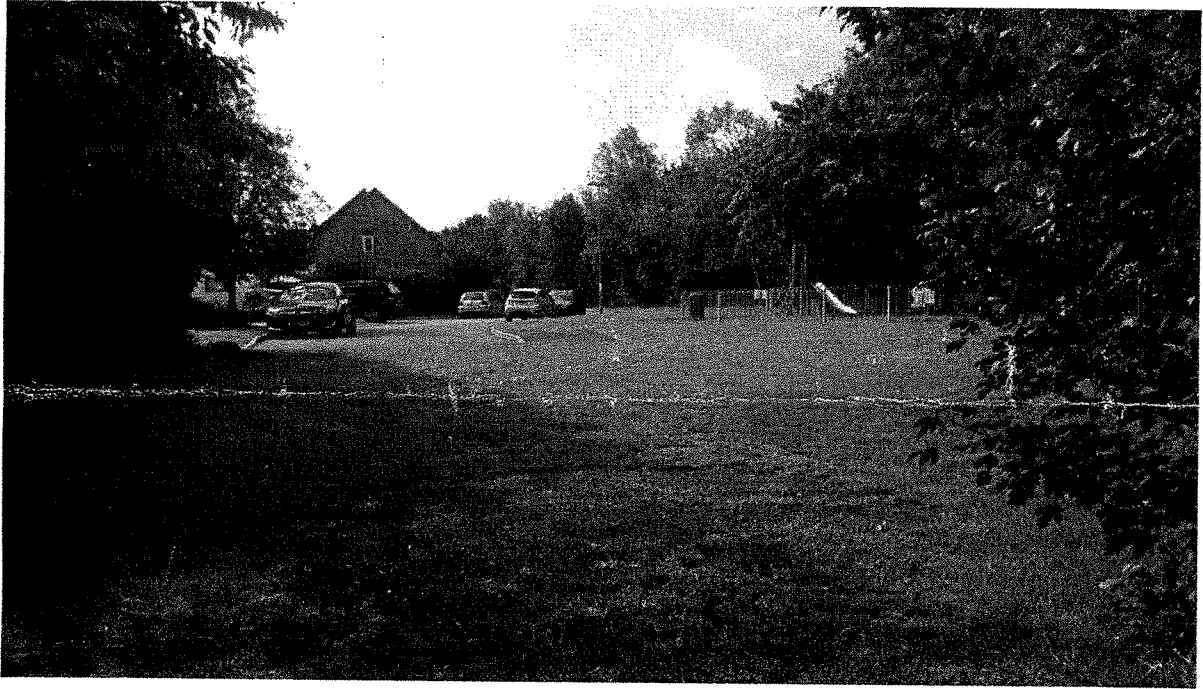


OUR OPEN SPACE AND PLAYAREA ARE UNDER THREAT.



The Parish Council agreed that the new housing development would pay for the play area in Wimborn Close to be improved and expanded., for the use of both estates. Access being via DPC land through our wildlife corridor.

I have since heard that the developers plan is to build a further 17 houses.

That is a total of 38 houses!

Can our open space and the play area support families of our 23 house development plus ¹⁴38 from the new development = 61 houses in total. ³⁵ 58

I don't think so and why should it? Why should our small open space be open to an estate far larger than ours? I strongly object to this site being used for the 21 house development let alone a ³⁸35 house development.
