The physical extension and earthworks of the track and field areas for vehicles and overnight stays is obvious from the roads into the village and. This is also confirmed by photos seen within the village. At this rate, if it is not stopped, we will have every weekend and Bank holiday ruined by this ever-increasing noise and the village will never be the same.
