Comments	My objection is twofold, firstly to the escalation of the use and size of the motocross track. I think it is suitable for a small local club to operate from on an occasional basis but think that the site is wholly unsuitable for a permanent and national fixture situated in close proximity to several villages mainly on grounds of noise pollution but also because this is an area enjoyed by many ramblers and bird watchers. My second objection is to the volume of traffic entering and exiting the track via a small rural road on a blind bend. The road links to the main A422 by means of a narrow country land where traffic has to pull over in order to pass each other. On several occasions I have been returning to Hornton and have been "trapped" by a continual stream of white vans and cars exiting the track. The vehicles very rarely pull over and continually drive on the verges ploughing them up in the winter months and spreading mud on to the road making it slippery. The exit is also on a blind bend and vehicles have pulled out in front of cars on many occasions. To summarise the access to the site is not fit for increased use and it's location is not suitable for a national track.
