Comments

I have lived in Hornton since 1993, enjoying the tranquility of village life...until recently. Clearly we were aware of occasional use of an informal track, but the noise was tolerable and only affected a few weekends each year. That has all changed in the last few years, it becoming very evident that the track has undergoing extensive engineering works and the number and scale of events has significantly ramped up. About three years ago I was talking to some ramblers passing our house...what a lovely village they said. "But how can you live with that dreadful racket?" Good question. The noise, especially when the prevailing wind blows, is intrusive, almost constant, extremely annoying and disruptive. Why bother to have a conservation area if you allow noise pollution on this scale...and allowed to continue with no planning consent ever. This is a blight, hugely damaging to the quality of life in Hornton, polluting and needs to be returned to an acceptable, modest scale. It should operate in line with what was intended in allowing occasional motorsport use on agricultural land, and returned to agricultural use between events. To my knowledge sheep cannot graze on dust.
