<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Access to and from the Oxford Road for the existing properties is already difficult as is exiting and entering the site for Banbury Rugby Club and Bannatynes. On exiting the existing properties you have to be aware of the traffic on the Oxford Road, the status of the traffic lights and vehicles joining the road from the site for Banbury Rugby Club and Bannatynes and Cotefield Nursery and housing estate. Entering the Banbury Rugby Club/Bannatynes' site from Banbury you have to be aware of traffic possibly turning right into the existing houses immediately after the lights with only a white lined area to provide some space for those vehicles. On exiting the Banbury Rugby Club/Bannatynes' site by turning right it is usually easier and quicker to turn left and then right into Cotefield Nursery and then turn left into the Oxford Road. More traffic accessing the Oxford Road from residential properties in that area will simply make the current situation more difficult and dangerous for both car drivers and pedestrians. For the above reasons I do not believe the planning application should be granted."/>
