Contrary to current requirements by many Planning Authorities it would seem that Cherwell DC are not requiring GHVDC to provide an electric vehicle charging infrastructure nor associated provision of vehicle charging points at visitor parking bays at Graven Hill.

We would wish to object / comment on this application and ask that Graven Hill Village Development Company be required to provide an electric vehicle charging infrastructure and associated provision of vehicle charging points at visitor parking bays both on phase one and future phases at Graven Hill as a condition of LDO planning approval.
