Comments	<input type="text" value="There are many reasons that this application should be turned down. The site is too close to the village of Hornton and to Hornton Grounds Farm. Having vast amounts of flammable and potentially explosive fuels so close to a village is unacceptable. How ever careful the operators may be there is almost certainly a high risk of spillages which would pollute watercourses and the surrounding land. As the proposal is for a 24hr operation there would no doubt be night time lighting which would disturb wildlife. The increased traffic flow of heavy vehicles would cause noise and pollution in an essentially rural area. The previous failed application to build the facility at Sugarswell on an industrial site would have been considerably more appropriate as it is not close to a village community."/>
