The storage of such quantities of fuel in a rural area is totally inappropriate. 158 tankers negotiating lanes with extreme gradients and bends in winter weather is a recipe for disaster. From my membership of the AMHB I can supply anecdotal evidence as well as numbers of the significant Brown Hare population in the quarry workings and beyond which would be severely damaged by 24 hour light and noise.
