The light pollution, noise levels, and potential environmental damage should any one of the submerged oil tanks leak will irreversibly damage our quiet, peaceful existence here in one of the most rural locations in Oxfordshire, not to mention the wildlife it would harm and the agricultural damage it would cause. The fact that they want to operate for 24 hours a day, seven days a week is quite frankly ludicrous for the location that they are proposing. One of the things we love the most about living where we do is the amount of stars you can see in the night sky, which would no doubt be lost with lights blazing 24/7 at the top of our garden! Most importantly, this is a completely inappropriate place for an industrial facility like this. This was made clear by Cherwell District Council only last year when this company tried to build the same facility on the nearby Sugarswell Industrial Estate.
