Comments	<input type="text" value="I wish to object strongly to the proposal to build a fuel depot on the site of Hornton Grounds Quarry. For the past 35 years I have been the proprietor of Varney's Garage, which is just a few hundred yards across the fields to the north, so I have first-hand experience of running a business in this very rural area. Throughout my time as proprietor, I have done my best to ensure that the activities of my business do not harm the environment of the area or disturb its rural tranquillity. We don't create loud noise, don't work late at night, don't work excessive hours at weekends. That's all part and parcel of being a good neighbour, as far as I am concerned. The way this fuel depot is intended to operate breaks all of those rules. It will cause light pollution all night and operate 24 hours a day, with the sound of lorries reversing during the night...not to mention the fact that hundreds of thousands of gallons of explosive and flammable fuel will be stored on a site far too close to houses for comfort. There are plenty of places in the area where this facility could be sited that would not create these kind of environmental problems. Perhaps the planners at Cherwell can help the fuel company do that."/>
