Comments	<p>We would like to object to the proposed planning application 20/02453/F. Being a local resident of the proposed route of large vehicles to and from the proposed new site we would like to object on the following criteria. 1. Quality of Life The proposed traffic route would severely impact the residents quality of life in Drayton, with the proposed increase of larger vehicles through the village which is already an excessively busy road with too many heavy good traffic. The Stratford Road has a vast quantity of larger vehicles to and from the quarries and other areas increasing the volume of traffic on a daily basis which dramatically affects the quality of life as residents as it currently stands. By increasing larger good traffic again it will increase the risk. Air & light pollution, local wildlife and the safety of our residents including many children. Living directly on the stratford road, daily we encounter near miss RTA's from the excess of traffic and the continual requests for the police force to introduce calming measures from the Parish Council. This proposed new development would aggravate this situation further and we fear a tragic accident to occur. 2. Child Safety The safety of residents must be of paramount importance and with increased large vehicle traffic this will put residents at much greater risk. There are many children in the village who have to catch school buses along the busy road or walk to the local secondary School. Without adequate places to cross the road as is, by increasing the traffic further this will become even more impossible and I fear a tragic accident will one day ensue. As a parent in the village, this proposed development would make it impossible for our child to walk safely through the village to school, to the bus. Nothing is more important than child safety. 3. Noise The increased in the village would be unbearable especially as this is a 24hr proposed site. With more and more people having to war at home due to COVID-19, the excess noise would make the village bearable. 4. House Prices A development of this nature will dramatically affect the house prices of the local area. These villages located on the outskirts of the Cotswolds have long since been a desirable place to live and attract a higher level of house price, which benefits the overall economy. A development of this nature will dramatically impact house prices, making it a far less desirable place to live. I fail to see the logical reason as why a fuel storage facility would be planned for an out of town rural village location as being proposed when there is ample space and opportunities nearer the major transport links to the M40 without affecting residents of these rural villages. As a villager i strongly urge you to deny this proposed application for the good of the economy, quietly of life and safety of residents as well as the natural habitats surrounding the villages.
