Comments	<input type="text" value="The small and winding A422 is already disproportionately overloaded with heavy Agricultural vehicles and quarry lorries on top of the normal traffic, school runs etc. We have also seen an increase in delivery vehicles through the pandemic. There are frequently speeding heavy goods vehicles through Wroxton, accidents at the very tight bend and near misses. It would create more tail backs and increase the likelihood of further accidents. The noise from these vehicles is disruptive, waking us up from 5am onwards and continuing late into the evening. Having flammable goods driven through a thatched village also does not seem like a great idea. The proposal will change the character of the broader area impacting on nature, wildlife, quality of life and some businesses in the area, which could adversely affect local employment at this very challenging time. It will increase wear on the roads and demand more regular maintenance and increased cost to the council. I am personally concerned about my asthma and the impact of diesel fumes on my breathing."/>
