Comments	<p>As a company, Certas Energy Ltd make a claim 'to being a responsible business we closely monitor the effect our work has on local communities, the environment and the workplace'. In light of this, we're surprised to learn of the proposal to develop the site at Hornton Grounds Quarry. We believe the answers to questions 19 and 22 of the application are disingenuous. The nature of operations and therefore 'opening hours' at the proposed development are, most certainly, of relevance and would have an adverse impact on the Grade II listed Hornton Grounds Farmhouse Bed & Breakfast, Hornton Grounds Farm, and walkers using the d'Arcy Dalton Way footpath. We feel there would also be significant environmental factors to be considered, relating to both the construction and operation of the site: a vast increase in the size and number of vehicles using the A422 and manoeuvring through local villages; light and noise pollution, and the additional risk of chemical pollution from hazardous substances; as well as the impact on livestock and wildlife.</p>
