Comments	<input type="text" value="The proposed location of this application is wholly unsuitable. The unnecessary damage to the local environment and roads is unacceptable when there are much more suitable urban sites available close to the M40. The planning proposal mentions the A422 as the access road but does not detail that, despite this previously being used as a main route, it was unsuitable and replaced by the M40. There is no way for the lorries and super tankers to leave the depot without encountering narrow roads or very steep hills. Going north, Sunrising Hill is a steep hill with a hair pin bend which is notorious for lorrys getting stuck halfway up, particularly in icy conditions. This is very dangerous as it creates a blindspot for cars trying to overtake the broken down lorry. Going towards Wroxton, there is a very tight hairpin bend which necessitates large vehicles to traverse onto the opposite side of the road. Towards the M40 at Gaydon there is another steep hill with a blindspot at the turning. The only other option is via Sugarswell Lane. This involves a steep hill into Tysoe or a journey through narrow country roads towards Brailes and Shipston. I do not see how the location can be viable with no suitable main route to and from the site for the numerous delivery lorries and in particular the super tankers that will deliver the oil."/>
