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1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1 Certas Energy are proposing to develop a brownfield site at Hornton Grounds Quarry into a new fuel storage and distribution depot east of the A422 in Oxfordshire.
- 1.1.2 Wormald Burrows Partnership Limited (WBP) has been appointed by Finsco Property Group on behalf of Certas Energy Ltd to assess the impact the development proposals will have on the surrounding transportation network, ascertain the availability of sustainable transport measures and determine if any mitigation measures are required to address residual impacts. This transportation assessment details this work in support of a forthcoming planning application.
- 1.1.3 This report assesses the existing conditions of the transportation network, both for public and private modes of transport, and then assesses the impact the proposed development will have on this network. The assessment will be made in terms of sustainability and assurance of the transportation network against the effect of traffic from the site, environmental impact, and safety.
- 1.1.4 A pre-application report (ref:19/02746/PREAPP) containing comments by Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) as Local Highway Authority (LHA) with regards to the depot was prepared by Cherwell District Council (CDC).
- 1.1.5 The report defines the scope of this assessment and the access requirements for the depot.



2 EXISTING CONDITIONS

2.1 Hornton Ground Quarry

- 2.1.1 The application site is situated in northern Oxfordshire on the boundary with Warwickshire in Hornton, which falls under the Cherwell District Council. Drawing 6289-803-Location Plan, which is provided in **Appendix A**, shows the location of the proposed development site.
- 2.1.2 The site comprises of the worked land of the Hornton Grounds Quarry, which is located approximately 1.2 kilometres south east of the village of Hornton and approximately 8 kilometres west of the town of Banbury. The existing buildings and yard of the quarry borders the western boundary of the site with arable land to the north, east and south.
- 2.1.3 Access to the quarry is taken from the A422 Stratford Road.
- 2.1.4 The village of Hornton lies approximately 1.2 kilometres north-east of the application site while Shenington lies approximately 2.0 kilometres south of the site. Upton House is located approximately 1.0 kilometre north of the site.

2.2 Baseline Transport Data

2.2.1 Road Network

- 2.2.2 The A422 Stratford Road is a single carriageway road with one lane in each direction. It is nominally 7.0m wide in the vicinity of Horton and has no footways. It is subject to the national speed limit.
- 2.2.3 Stratford Road is a part of the A422, which is an east-west distributor road that extends from Bedford in the east to Worcester in the west by way of Milton Keynes, Buckingham, Banbury and Stratford-upon-Avon. The A422 provides the shortest journey time route to the site from Banbury.
- 2.2.4 The A422 joins the M40 to the east of Banbury, the M40 being the main motorway link between London and Birmingham. The A422 also joins the A429 12km to the west of the site, the A429 running north-south from Warwick to Cirencester.



- 2.2.5 Shutford Road joins A422 Stratford Road 180m to the north of the quarry access. It is a single carriageway road with one lane in each direction and has a nominal width of 5.0 metres. The road extends 4km south from its junction with A422, at one point being named The Plain Road, passing by the villages of Shutford and Balscote, and forming a route to the A361 at the village of Bloxham.
- 2.2.6 At the town of Lower Tadmarton, it junctions with the B4035. The B4035 extends from the village of Aston Subedge in the west, which is located just north west of the town of Chipping Camden, to Banbury in the east passing through Shipston-on-Stour.

2.2.7 Vehicular Access

- 2.2.8 Vehicular access to the application site is *via* the existing Hornton Grounds Quarry access road from the A422. The access road is an unkerbed asphalt surfaced road that allows two-way movements and is approximately 7.30 metres wide.
- 2.2.9 At the access junction, the A422 widens to 10.0m to provide a ghost island right turn lane into the site. The access road approach lane flares at the junction and the left turn in entry radius is in excess of 15m, these being designed for heavy vehicle movements required for quarry use.

2.2.10 Pedestrian and Cycle Access

- 2.2.11 Two public right of ways exists near Horton Grounds Quarry. A bridleway, 255/5/10, extends from the A422, 80m south-east of it junction with the access road, for a length of approximately 1.57 kilometres in an east and north direction to the village of Hornton.
- 2.2.12 Footpath 339/8/10 runs between Shenington and Shutford Road, joining it 90m south of its junction with the A422.
- 2.2.13 Grass verges exist along both side of the A422 carriageway.
- 2.2.14 Access by bicycle is available *via* the existing local road network.

2.2.15 Bus Services

2.2.16 The nearest pair of bus stops to the application site is located on Well Lane, Shenington, a walking distance of approximately 1.8 km away. The stops are served by Routes 6 and 7, which are operated by Johnson's Excelbus.



- 2.2.17 The bus routes run between Stratford-upon-Avon and Banbury. The route allows staff to travel between Shenington and Banbury Bus Station.
- 2.2.18 The application site is accessed *via* Footpath 339/8/10 from the bus stop.
- 2.2.19 Copies of the bus timetables are provided in **Appendix B**.

2.2.20 Rail Links

- 2.2.21 The nearest railway station to the application site is in Banbury approximately 9.0 kilometres south and east of the application site.
- 2.2.22 The Banbury Railway Station lies on the Chiltern Main Line and is served by Chiltern Railways. The Chiltern Main Line links London (Marylebone) with Birmingham *via* High Wycombe, Banbury and Warwick.
- 2.2.23 Bus Routes 6 and 7 links Banbury Bus Station to Shenington. The bus station is located approximately 350 metres walking distance from the railway station.
- 2.2.24 A copy of the Chiltern Main Line Route Map is provided in **Appendix C**.

2.3 Personal Injury Accident Records

- 2.3.1 Personal injury accident records were obtained from the 'Crash map' website for the local road network surrounding the proposed development covering the most recent five-year period available from 2015 – 2019. Copies of the full records are available in **Appendix D**.
- 2.3.2 A total of 14 personal injury accidents were recorded in the study area. Eight of these accidents resulted in slight injuries to those involved, five resulted in serious injuries and one in a fatality.
- 2.3.3 The fatal accident occurred along the A422 when a vehicle left the carriageway and collided with a tree. The location of the accident was approximately 1.9 kilometres west of the A422/Sugarswell Lane junction.
- 2.3.4 All five serious injury accidents occurred along the A422. One of these occurred when a car turned right into a motorcyclist at the crossroad junction of A422/Kineton Road.



- 2.3.5 Another two of the serious injury accidents occurred at the crossroads junction of A422/Tysoe Road where both accidents involved two vehicles colliding with each other.
- 2.3.6 The remaining accident resulting in serious injury to those involved along the A422 occurred at the A422/Sugarswell Lane junction when a vehicle collided with two cyclists causing serious injury to both cyclists.
- 2.3.7 The remaining accident causing serious injury occurred along Epwell Road, approximately 1.8 kilometres south of the Sugarswell Lane/Shenington Road/Epwell Road crossroads junction when a single vehicle lost control and collided with an unidentified object.
- 2.3.8 Four of the eight accidents resulting in slight injuries to those involved occurred along the A422, with two of them located at the crossroads junction of A422/Tysoe Road.
- 2.3.9 Another accident resulting in slight injuries to motorcyclists occurred along the Sun Rising Hill bend of the A422, west of the A422/Sugarswell Lane junction when the riders lost control of their motorcycles.
- 2.3.10 The remaining accident resulting in slight injuries along the A422 occurred approximately 150 metres south of the A422/Shutford Road junction between a driver and a cyclist causing slight injury.
- 2.3.11 Two accidents causing slight injuries to those involved occurred at the crossroads junction of Rattlecombe Road and the unclassified north-south road directly east of Shenington. One involved the collision of a bus and a car and the other a collision between two cars.
- 2.3.12 An accident along the Plain 500m north of the Banbury Road/Shutford Road junction between a cyclist and a car, resulting in slight injury.
- 2.3.13 The remaining accident causing slight injury occurred within the village of Tysoe when a motorcycle collided with a vehicle performing a U-turn.
- 2.3.14 From these accident records, no clusters of accidents nor common causes of accidents are apparent within the study area over the last five-year period.



3 PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

3.1 Introduction

3.1.1 Certas Energy are proposing to develop a brownfield site on Hornton Grounds Quarry into a new fuel storage and distribution depot east of the A422. Drawing 6289-801 Rev F 'Proposed Site Layout', which is provided in **Appendix E**, shows the extent of the development proposals prepared by Trident Engineering Consultants.

3.2 Site Layout

- 3.2.1 The site proposals consist of two segregated areas with the larger area access *via* an electronic automatic sliding gate. Two pedestrian gates are proposed to link the areas.
- 3.2.2 The smaller of the two areas will encompass the office building and staff and visitor parking, and the larger area will contain fuel tanks, loading areas and parking for the fuel tanker trucks.

3.3 Site Access and Parking

- 3.3.1 Access to the site is proposed *via* the existing Hornton Grounds Quarry access road. The access road extends from its junction with the A422 to a shared access between the existing adjacent quarry and the proposed site.
- 3.3.2 The shared access will be a simple priority junction, with priority given to traffic from the existing quarry.
- 3.3.3 A total of 19 staff and visitor parking spaces, including a single disabled space and a space with an electrical charging point will be provided within the smaller of the two areas that includes the office building.
- 3.3.4 Fifteen parking spaces are proposed within the larger area for tanker trucks as they will remain on site overnight.
- 3.3.5 Pedestrian access between the office building and the tanker yard is achievable by means of two pedestrian gates. However, no vehicular access between the two areas is possible.
- 3.3.6 Secure cycle parking will also be provided on site for staff and visitors.



4 TRAFFIC IMPACT

4.1 Staff and Car Trips

- 4.1.1 Certas Energy has advised that a total of 17 staff members will be employed as part of the site operations. However, as staff members will be working shifts, not all will be present on site at the same time.
- 4.1.2 Of the 17 staff members, 14 are drivers. Each driver will work one shift per day from Monday to Friday over a 24-hour period, and only half of them will work on a Saturday from 06:00 to 18:00.
- 4.1.3 This means that a maximum number of ten private vehicle trips (seven tanker drivers and three office staff) will arrive at the site and ten exit the site per shift from Monday to Friday. Therefore, a maximum number of only 34 two-way private commuter vehicle trips could be generated per weekday by the proposed development, excluding any occasional office deliveries or other admin trips
- 4.1.4 On a Saturday a maximum number of only 20 two-way private commuter vehicle trips could be generated by the proposed development.
- 4.1.5 Any new staff members are expected to be employed from the town of Banbury or from the neighbouring villages.

4.2 Depot Fuel Tanker Trips

- 4.2.1 As stated in paragraph 3.3.4, a total of 15 depot tanker parking spaces are proposed as part of the development. All tankers will be parked on site overnight.
- 4.2.2 It is estimated that up to 158 tanker trips will be generated per week from Monday to Saturday. This results in approximately 14 two-way depot tanker trips per weekday and seven two-way depot tanker trips on a Saturday with the possibility of one additional two-way weekday trip and one additional two-way Saturday trip.
- 4.2.3 It is proposed that each weekday will consist of two shifts with seven drivers allocated per shift and each driver doing only one two-way trip per day.
- 4.2.4 Similarly, seven drivers will be employed on a Saturday with each driver only doing one two-way trip on that day.



- 4.2.5 As the area that houses the fuel tanks and tanker parking spaces has only two loading gantries, the maximum number of tankers exiting the site at any single moment is two. This means that tanker departure times will be staggered during each shift.
- 4.2.6 The application site will serve a 50-mile radius area of Banbury, which includes towns and cities as far afield as Birmingham, Leicester, Bedford, Luton, Reading, Swindon, Gloucester and Worcester.
- 4.2.7 Due to the large area serviced by the depot and the vastly varying delivery distances, site tankers will also return to the depot at times spread out during a shift.

4.3 Depot Fuel Tanker Routing

- 4.3.1 A full 360-degree route analysis was undertaken to include the cities and towns listed in paragraph 4.2.6 above, namely Birmingham, Leicester, Bedford, Luton, Reading, Swindon, Gloucester and Worcester.
- 4.3.2 For both outgoing and return journey, all large fuel tanker vehicles would turn out into the A422 and as such have no need to travel along the narrow rural roads serving the surrounding villages. Thus, trips will be contained to 'A' class roads until reaching the final destination and there will be a negligible impact on the local highway network and the villages surrounding them.

4.4 Development Access

- 4.4.1 Access to the site is proposed *via* the existing Hornton Grounds Quarry access road. The access road extents from its junction with the A422 to a shared access between the existing adjacent quarry and the proposed site.
- 4.4.2 This shared access will be a simple priority type junction, with priority being given to traffic from the existing quarry.
- 4.4.3 A tracking plan for the area of the access from the quarry that will be shared between the existing quarry and the proposed fuel depot has been undertaken to confirm that the existing access can accommodate both traffic without conflict. Drawing E4040/790 'Site Access Tracking' is provided in **Appendix F**.



5 CONCLUSIONS

- 5.1.1 Certas Energy are proposing to develop a brownfield site on Hornton Grounds Quarry into a new fuel storage and distribution depot east of the A422.
- 5.1.2 Access to the application site will be *via* the existing Hornton Grounds Quarry access road off the A422.
- 5.1.3 A total of 19 staff and visitor car parking spaces, including a single disabled space and a space with an electrical charging point will be provided for as well as parking spaces for 15 depot fuel tankers that will park on site overnight. Cycle parking will also be provided for at the application site.
- 5.1.4 A total of 17 staff members will be employed as part of the site operations. Fourteen drivers will work one shift per day from Monday to Friday over a 24-hour period with seven drivers employed on a Saturday from 06:00 to 18:00.
- 5.1.5 It is estimated that up to 158 fuel tanker trips will be generated per week; this equates to an average of only 29 trips per day based on a week of five and a half days. This includes the smaller depot tankers delivering fuel to locations within a 50-mile radius of Banbury from Monday to Saturday, as well as the larger articulated tanker trucks bringing fuel to the depot from Monday to Sunday.
- 5.1.6 A full 360-degree route analysis was undertaken to include the cities and towns considered to fall within the 50-mile radius delivery area.
- 5.1.7 This routing analysis demonstrates that the tanker trips predicted to be generated by the proposed development will be contained to 'A' class roads until reaching their final destination and have a negligible impact on the local highway network and villages surrounding them.





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

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


Route map for Johnson's Excelbus service 6 (outbound)


