Comments	<input type="text" value="My family concern and objections below 1. Increased HGV traffic through the village including 28 of the largest fuel tankers passing through the village every day. If you read Warwickshire County Council's comment you will see that they are not objecting, but have a caveat that all traffic must travel southbound on the A422 through Drayton and Wroxton and not through Warkwickshire! 2. The risk of oil spillage and ground pollution in the event of an accident could be catastrophic. (I believe Balscote experienced an incident.) 3. Air, noise and light pollution 4. Road safety, increase in accidents 5. If this planning is approved this could pave the way for other industrial plants which have no place in a rural area (this brown site is currently restricted to quarrying only.)
