We are writing, as Hornton residents, to register with you our deep concern about the proposed development of a fuel depot at Hornton Grounds Quarry and the possibility that the consideration of the application by the CDC planning committee may be further delayed.

Our opposition to the application has already been made clear and is logged on the CDC planning portal but we would now like to ask that you do all you can to ensure that the application is considered on December 10, and no later, and that it is rejected.

Our main objection to the application concerns the guardianship of the beautiful Ironstone Downs landscape. The proposed site for the fuel depot, so close to the Cotswold Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, is completely inappropriate and allowing the construction and operation of the depot there would set a very dangerous precedent for further desecration of the landscape.

In concluding, we'd also like to draw your attention to the reference in the applicant's submission to the proposed site as being a brownfield site. It is not, neither is it accessible by public transport.
