I write urging you to accept the recommendations of planning officer Bob Neville for the above application and refuse planning.

- The proposed development is in an unjustified and unsustainable form in a rural location
- By virtue of its siting, scale and form and associated lighting the development would appear as an alien feature within the rural landscape
- Proposal fails to demonstrate safe and suitable access
- Frequent HGV movements through residential areas including Drayton and Wroxton, Hardwick and Ruscote, to the detriment of the living environment of these areas
- The applicant has failed to demonstrate an appropriate surface water drainage strategy and mitigation measures necessary in the event of spillage of fuel

These are very serious problems with the application, with implications for potential environmental damage and the safety of road users and roadside dwellers in the aforementioned villages

Councillors, I look to you to make the right decision on behalf of the communities of the affected area
