- Native buffer planting(NBP) around pond area (As recommended by Ecologist, Casey Griffin)**
- 120m2, plants @ 1m c/s
- Crataegus monogyna (60-80cm ht BR) 25% 30No
- Corylus avellana (60-80cm ht BR) 15% 24No
- Cornus sanguinea (60-80cm ht BR) 20% 18No
- Prunus spinosa (60-80cm ht BR) 20% 24No
- Rosa canina (60-80cm ht BR) 20% 24No
- Plant in species groups of 3-5No Total 120No
- Plant material to be of local provenance

- SPECIFICATION NOTES**
- Topsoil**
- Planting areas to a minimum depth of 400mm.
- Planting**
- Weed growth to be sprayed off using approved translocated herbicide.
  - Cultivate and prepare hedge line incorporating fertiliser @ 50gms/m2 & 50mm depth of mushroom compost.
  - Native shrubs to be pit planted incorporating fertiliser @ 25gms/pit.
  - Bark Mulch: 50mm depth x 1m wide to hedge line.
- Rabbit Protection (Provisional-Subject to site assessment of rabbit damage risk)**
- Clear spiral guard (60cmx38mm) to native hedging & shrubs. Plus canes (90cm ht) to support spirals on transplants.
- Maintenance 12 months from Practical Completion**
- Planting Areas**
- Weed, water, prune as necessary and carry out replacement of failed hedging and shrubs.

- Services must be located prior to tree pit excavation and planting works.
