I object to the scrub clearance within the LWS, for the following reasons: * Some of the oak saplings have formed a spinney, which would take 20 years to grow to its current height if planted * Bicester's tree cover is extraordinarily low: there are - at present - no woodlands within walking distance of the town centre * One of the delights of the LWS is to watch the growth of trees and plants * The oak trees on the site are mature, and there should be replacements ready before they die * The overgrown hedgerows are good for biodiversity - particularly birds I am pleased that the LWS will not be developed on, however, I would like to see it remain wild: not chopped, cleared, or pruned.
