Comments	<input type="text" value="Please can the Council reject the plans to build two blocks of houses on the nature Conservation Target Area (CTA). This land should be reserved for biodiversity improvement, not housing. There is a huge amount of wildlife on this area and we need to protect it from all the choas which construction work brings with it. It is great that the developers have promised not to build on the Local Wildlife Site inside the CTA, and also to fund a Wildlife Management Plan. But it is surely better to increase the density of the housing west of the Langford Brook and leave the CTA for wildlife. Please ensure that the developer's environmental assessment includes the problems of noise and air pollution from the dust, the damage to the road and nuisance to residents from lorries bringing in material to raising the land out of the flood plain. The flood plain is there for a reason and raising the level will only move flood water elsewhere. Thank you."/>
