The area on which the plans are proposed is a vital area of flood plain which, if built on, would likely cause the run off water to find its way into Old Langford. Old Langford is an area in which the residents pay a premium to live in. House prices are a good deal higher there than elsewhere in Bicester and this added risk would almost certainly drop house prices. It seems an all too sad event that green belt land is being eaten up and Cherwell Council have a good opportunity to highlight their values in this area. The high street is almost empty in area's and doesn't currently have the ability to cope with an ever expanding population. I am very concerned for the welfare of local wildlife to the area as well.
