<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Yarnton is already overloaded with traffic and an increasing population with insufficient facilities and resources to sustain a functional way of life for residents. There are insufficient school places meaning children will have to travel to access education increasing traffic further. Also, there are no jobs in Yarnton, therefore necessitating travel to work for new residents and increasing traffic flow on roads. Since previous housing developments Yarnton residents have to live with excessive noise pollution and poor air quality due to increased traffic and poor traffic flow on its roads. The council nor police seem to have the capability to manage this. Unless developers are willing to fund a bypass for yarnton the impact of further development in and around this village will result in environmental damage and adverse living conditions for residents, which is likely to directly impact on health and well-being leaving the council and developers open to being sued."/>
