- T1 Sycamore, Trim clear of the BT cables and telegraph pole to create a 1m clearance.
 T2+3 Laburnum and Sycamore, Trim clear of the BT cables to create 50cm clearance.
 T4 Laburnum, Laetiporus FFB on the main stem at 1m, extensive dieback of a large proportions of the crown, Fell to near ground level.
- T5 Spruce. Trim clear of the BT cables to create 50cm clearance.
- T6 Malus, Reduce to 4.5m in height and reshape, removing approximately 60% of the canopy.
- G7 Pine, Crown raise to provide a 2.5m clearance from ground level and prune away from the adjacent BT cable to create a 30cm clearance. Prune clear of neighbouring residence to create 1m clearance, remove major deadwood.
