Comments	<p>This application is virtually identical to the previous application 20/02060/F which was rejected . The only difference is the phrasing "Change of use of land to a mixed use for the keeping of horses (existing) and as a residential caravan site for 4no gypsy families. Each with two caravans (including no more than 4no static caravans / mobile homes) together with the laying of hardcore." which has been amended to "Certificate of Lawfulness Existing for mixed use of land for agricultural and as a caravan site for residential purposes" - i.e. deleting "for 4no gypsy families. Each with two caravans (including no more than 4no static caravans / mobile homes) together with the laying of hardcore." THIS IS THE SAME THING! This is a flagrant rehash hoping to bore people into submission and to pander to councils unwillingness to stand up against them I echo the sentiments of Sheila Jaunt and Rosemary Cannon in their objections. On the Cherwell District Councils own website it shows the applications submitted on this site : 05/00198/F 3rd Feb 2005 Erection of Stables 06/00593/F 23rd Mar 2006 Livestock and Hay Store 13/00593/F 27th Mar 2013 Hardstanding for a pig pen -NOWHERE does it grant planning for residential caravan. You cant just make something like that up!! Saying you have planning permission to sell the land to someone else does not make it real and it shouldnt then force planning departments into accepting something that wasnt granted After listening to Mollington residents regarding the applicants current site on the Farnborough Road and how it has completely disregarded the original planning granted.
