<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I feel I must raise objections yet again to this planning proposal. The application appears to have been tweaked only slightly since it was last rejected by the planning committee, and nothing in the revised application seems to address the issues that I raised previously. In short my objections remain the same: there is already an approved traveller site on the Mollington road by the Farnborough turning. This has grown significantly since planning was granted, and the same thing will happen on this site. Cropredy and Great Bourton are separate villages, and approving this application will set a precedence for further development. There is regular flooding on this road, and it is impassable more frequently now when we get heavy rainfall, development on this site will only make the situation worse. The term mixed agricultural used in this application is somewhat vague, and leaves the door open for all sorts of uses, my worry being that many from the traveller community will use said space to graze livestock, and clog up and already busy road with horse boxes and the like, this is unacceptable, especially given the huge traffic problems we already have to endure with school parents 'abandoning' their vehicles when dropping of and collecting children. Twice a day, this road is an absolute nightmare, and more traffic is not the answer. I strongly object yet again to this application and trust that the planning committee will reject this and all future developments on this land"/>
