Procurement (Material & Labour)

Parkway Construction shall endeavor to investigate, promote and procure where practical, materials that are either recycled, are from sustainable sources, or are eco-friendly. We collaborate with clients and designers to change material specifications, or construction methods if appropriate, in order to reach a more environmentally friendly outcome for the scheme, whilst still maintaining the highest build standards.

It is our aim to source materials from local suppliers, manufacturers and (SME) companies that share our environmental and sustainable values.

It is also our aim to source trades and labor locally or from local businesses and (SME) companies in order to promote our environmental and sustainable values.

As a building construction company we use a vast array of materials. These materials will be predominantly purchased from local companies having ISO 14001 accreditation, a certification of their environmental management systems. However, purchases from companies without accreditation, but who demonstrate a commitment of environmental awareness shall also be considered.

We treat our supply chain "partners" fairly and responsibly and ensure that together we operate in a safe and environmentally responsible way. Together we promote and develop sustainable solutions and best practices on all of our projects

The purchasing of materials shall always be monitored in order to continually reduce the need for wastage.

Timber for Example.

All timber shall be sourced from a certified scheme such as The Forestry Stewardship Council (FSC), The Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC), Or The Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI).

A Certificate of Conformity should also be available from our preferred suppliers in order to confirm documentary evidence that the timber has derived from a sustainable source.
