<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="The valley between Sibford Ferris and Burdrop has always been a area of outstanding beauty and a feature of the area. Planning has been refused consistently and continually to all previous applications for planning and there has been no change to the valley, maintaining it as a asset to the village. If a barn is constructed in the valley it would end the status as an area of outstanding beauty. There is not a need for a barn for one small field which has very limited agricultural use. The owners have no agricultural knowledge, expertise or background to sustain a living from this area of land, to need a barn. Finally the problem of access onto the Sibford hills would be a major problem for Highways. This is a dangerous section of road being narrow, on a bend and steep sided. Any vehicles entering or leaving this field would increase to chance of accidents and course disruption to the existing flow of traffic."/>
