Comments	<input type="text" value="This scheme does not hold up to reality. This is a conservation area, which is very clear to all who live in the Sibfords. A barn to service a vineyard would be completely inappropriate taking into account the size of the area. Camping and social meetings outside the confines of the public house boundary would be awful for neighbouring inhabitants, in the lovely untouched preserved quiet valley. I believe that vines only really need planting with a spade pruning with pair of secateurs and spraying with a knapsack. Then picking the grapes with a basket. These items don't need a large shed. So as suggested by the applicant the shed is actually intended eventually, sooner rather than later, for other purposes of social activities, as stated. If the tents need concealing between the vines as suggested by the applicant, he is acknowledging before he even starts that they might be unsightly. This chosen site is unsuitable. Therefore I object on the grounds that this application is inappropriate for this area of conservation."/>
