David Wilson Homes - Ref. 20/03391/DISC - Comments 12 / 01 / 21 Landscaping : - The developer should be advised that the Salt Way Action Group (SWAG) is a group of volunteers dedicated to the maintenance and enhancement of the environment and wild-life habitat of the Way. A contact can be provided, as it would be sensible for the developer's activities along the Salt Way boundary to be co-ordinated with those of the Group, with particular reference to the Environmental Statement and the viewpoint / /outlooks of the existing residents of Sycamore Drive, and Beaconsfield Rd. It is noted that the hard surfacing of the paths connecting to the Way terminate at the site boundary. This surfacing should be continued to link to the existing path surface (by agreement with O.C.C. as Highway Authority) to avoid a muddy area of grass being generated - this to ensure the safety of users. A view of the connections at the Morris Homes development (Parsons Piece) shows what is possible. Public Artwork: - Is this the best that can be provided? What is the relevance of the 'village pump' to this development? That which is being proposed hardly seems worth the effort! Surely something more prominent, imaginative and relevant can be provided for this 'quality' development. If the developer's imagination is so limited, then he should be referred to the examples in Spanish towns where some relevant, interesting and amusing items are provided. In this case a full-size figure of a salt carrying packhorse and drover would be relevant. Alternatively Ward Members and the Town / Parish Council should be invited to provide some ideas more suitable for a site of this prominence. On street traffic control: - No comment except to reiterate (as communicated already to the County Council) that the positioning of parking facilities at White Post Road and the location of the existing and new pedestrian crossing facilities are, in my opinion, going to result in a dangerous prospect for parents taking their children to Bishop Loveday School. I am again making this point to O.C.C., but the developer should be aware .
