<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Dear Mr. Chadwick, PLANNING APPLICATION REF: 20/03467/F I am writing to strongly object the above planning application ref: 20/03467/F. The proposed development gives raise to future and unprecedented ribbon developments which will ruin the tranquil and ancient monument of Deddington Castle grounds. In 2013 a similar proposal, for a number of dwellings on the grounds behind St. Thomas Street was submitted (Planning reference: 13/01941/OUT). This proposal was rejected on the grounds of being situated within the proximity of the castle grounds and hence being detrimental to the ancient monuments setting (English Heritage Ref: P00377830). St. Thomas Street is significantly further away than the Poplars. The Poplars is adjacent to the Castle, and therefore this argument is most relevant and applicable. I would also like to point out the proposed development will invade my privacy as the current scheme has windows directed into my property. I look forward to your comments, Susie Minshaw"/>
