Hello

I am a resident of Deddington and have lived here for 12 years. 3 years ago my young family and I moved from The Daedings on the other side of the village to Hopcraft Lane so we could be nearer to the castle and green open spaces that surround this end of the village. I have now been made aware of yet more houses wanting to be erected in our conservation area and more notably that these houses will be seen from the ancient monument site known locally as the castle grounds. The field behind our current house wanted to have 7 houses built on it but the English Heritage saw fit to decline this due to its closeness to the castle grounds. The latest proposed building site is even closer to the castle grounds and would ruin the openness associated with walking around these grounds.

Deddington has already contributed to the Districts housing needs by erecting 85 (opposed) houses plus there are 2 or 3 other large sites with new housing going on to them.

Please put my objections forward to more unnecessary houses being built in a conservation green belt area just so a building company and landowner can get rich.
